

DEAR PARISHIONERS OF ST. ANTHONY OF PADUA CHURCH & ANNUNCIATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY CHURCH,

Family Life Expresses the Life of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph

On this the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph, we are reminded of our own calling to let the Holiness of the Holy Family live in our own family life. Family life is the environment where our calling to follow Jesus Christ as our Lord and Savior finds expression. It is in family life that we grow and develop our potential for good or bad. It is so important we strive to let God be the center of our family and let God lead us in good growth.

I would like to point out the need for Family Prayer in home life. Family Prayer is a connection to church life. When Dad and Mom gather together with their children in prayer, Jesus is present and family life joins church life in becoming a “school of prayer”. It is here children see that God is important to Dad and Mom. It is here children see following God’s way of life is what we do in our family. It is here Dad and Mom exercises their own baptismal priesthood by both coming to God in prayer and leading their own children in their relationship with God.

Father Conley Bertrand, author of the “Come, Lord Jesus! Program” has developed a program of prayer for Families. This program is simple to use in the family. The family gets together for family prayer once a week. Father Bertrand has a seven-step outline for the prayer. In the time the family has set aside, the family follows the outline and tries to do as many steps as possible. As the family has experience with the program, the family will be able to do all seven steps.

The family prayer together involves thanksgiving, petition, reading the Bible, discussion on the Bible reading, a commentary on the Gospel and Catechism of the Catholic Church, prayer of Spiritual Communion, and closing prayer of a blessing for the family.

“Come, Lord Jesus! For Families” is a formation for God-centered family life. It is focused on Jesus Christ. It builds a family heritage of faith in Jesus Christ.

I encourage families at both Annunciation and St. Anthony Churches to be open to the Come, Lord Jesus! For Families Program. Ms. Maggie Vidrine at Annunciation and Ms. Angie Aguillard at St. Anthony will help families in the Religious Formation Programs with the “Come, Lord Jesus! For Families Program”. Please be open to it and use in in family life.

At the same time, I would also like to point out the need for Family Meals in home life. I am told that families

need to have at least five (5) family meals each week for the dynamics of family life to be effective. These meals could be breakfast, lunch, or supper. It could be any combination of meals. The important thing I am told is that families gather together spending time together. During the meal, talk about life, current events, work and school, family, neighbors, etc. It is good to do more than five family meals a week. But if a family does not do a minimum of five meals, then the dynamics of family life do not have a chance to work effectively.

With the use of both the “Come, Lord Jesus! For Families Program” and with the Family meals in the home - the whole family “falls in love” with God and grows in God’s love. Plus there is human formation happening.

Faith formation and human formation can be described this way: The whole family appreciates each other in God’s love and is able to reach out to each other in love. A special bond and communion grows between family members. Parents are able to influence the innermost depths of their children’s hearts and leave an impression that the future events in their lives will not be able to destroy them. Their children begin to understand themselves as a person made in God’s image and begin to see the Christian meaning of being a person. By making family prayer and family meals part of their lives, families increase and strengthen their family unity. Families experience and partake in God’s communion of life. Families have a special happiness and peace. Families have deep appreciation of each other’s good points and weak points. Families encourage each other and forgive each other. Families are better Christians and are Good News in our society.

Prayer for Families

Almighty God, you set the solidarity in families. We commend to you the homes where your people dwell. Remove from us all bitterness and pride and fill us with the love of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph, through the same Christ our Lord. Amen.

**Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph,
Cycle C – Luke 2:41-52**

Although Jesus apparently understood from a tender age how he related to God (“Did you not know that I must be in my Father’s house?”), Jesus also knew that he owed appropriate respect to his parents. This is why Jesus stayed in their home in Nazareth and was obedient to them. Their direction, their teachings, their example, and their rules would all have shaped Jesus in his humanity. It was thanks in no small part to the matriarch and patriarch of the Holy Family that Jesus “advanced in wisdom and age and favor before God and man.”

We should be advancing in these ways too! The Holy Family serves as a beautiful model for us in this regard. They help us learn how to submit our lives to the loving leadership of our heavenly Father. But more than this, Mary and Joseph also serve as intercessors who, like any faithful family member or friend, want to pray with us and for us. Let us turn, then, to the intercession of the Holy Family asking that our families may be holy too.


